Supervisor Meeting

February 24, 2010

Attendees: Aaron McIntyre, Wendell Fenton. Also present at the request of the supervisors: Matt Houtman, Township Engineer and Russell Drumheller, Code Enforcement Officer

Agenda Items:

- (1) George Thorpe, Vice chairman of the Chadds Ford Board of Supervisors has asked the board for a monetary contribution of \$5000.00 to support the operations of the Brandywine Battlefield Park. The board responded with questions as to the support to be offered by other municipalities. As of this meeting date the supervisors have not received any information requested to help make the decision as to the amount of the twp. contribution. Possibly contribute \$2,500.00 with no commitment for future contributions. **No action taken**
- (2) Audit Draft: It was reported that the firm of Tim Umbreit has submitted a request to provide audit services for the year 2010 for a cost of \$2,950.00. **motion was made by Aaron McIntyre and seconded by Wendell Fenton to accept Tim Umbreit's proposal. Motion carried.**
- (3) Eagle Scout Project: The Eagle Scout project of installing walkway lighting at the twp. building will be completed sometime between 3-27 and 4-1 depending on the weather. No action taken
- (4) Tax collection compensation: Solicitor Tom Oeste gave a brief description of the Tax resolution to the public. **Motion to approve resolution #2010-02-24-1 was made by Aaron McIntyre and seconded by Wendell Fenton. Motion carried**
- (5) Road Master report: Supervisor Fenton read briefly a written report submitted by the road master Dave Allen. Several residents commented that the road crew performed an excellent job providing safe streets during these recent snow storms.
- (6) Crosslands subdivision: **Action-- final approved plans were signed by the supervisors.**
- (7) Historic Ordinance amendments: Solicitor Tom Oeste will send the final draft to the Chester County Planning Commission as required by the MPC for their review and comments. He is hoping to have the final draft presented to the Board of supervisors at the April meeting.
- (8) Planning Commission: Continuing to work on the Zoning Ordinance updates with the county.
