

December 9, 2014

The Board of Supervisors of Pennsbury Township held a regular meeting on Tuesday, December 9, 2014 at 7 p.m. in the township building. Present were Supervisors Scottoline, Fenton, McIntyre, Solicitor Oeste and Manager Kathleen Howley. The minutes of the meeting of November 19, 2014 and also the open space public hearing on November 19, 2014 were approved as submitted.

**Township Manager Kathleen Howley** reported the following:

1. The **proposed 2015 budget** was duly advertised for adoption and posted November 5, 2015. It is a balanced budget of \$1,560,434. There will be no tax increase for 2015. Mills will stay at .7 for general fund and .79 for open space. With no further discussion a motion to adopt the budget as presented was made by Mr. Scottoline, seconded by Mr. McIntyre and unanimously adopted. It will be posted on the website.
2. The Board of Supervisors on motion duly made and seconded adopted a resolution accepting the Brandywine Valley Scenic Byway Corridor Management Plan as prepared by the Brandywine Conservancy dated September, 2014. The renewal of the intergovernmental cooperation agreement establishing the commission will be advertised for adoption at the January 5, 2015 meeting.
3. The organizational meeting will be held at 7 p.m. on January 5, 2015 followed by the regular BOS meeting for January. The auditor's organizational meeting will be held at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, January 6, 2015.

**Road Report** – Dave Allen submitted a report stating that the crew continue to skin patch and trim trees, weather permitting. Pipe replacement for Cossart Road will take place next week. A new backhoe has been ordered and will be delivered early 2015. The first snow event of the season on November 26<sup>th</sup> went well.

Rusty Drumheller reported he continues to work on inspections at Crosslands. The renovation of the reception area has not started yet and the Wellness Center final testing should take place in the next few weeks. He also stated that permits, in general, have been high this year and should level off in 2015.

Dennis Smith stated the Planning Commission's last two meetings dealt with the update of the SALDO. They continue to make progress and hope to finish their portion by June, 2015. The Board asked that they get a copy of the draft now rather than wait until it is done. Ms. Howley stated that John Snook is working on that and should have something for review by year end.

A bill list dated December 9, 2015 numbering 15191-15243, state fund 325, 326 were submitted and approved for payment by the Board. With no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
