The Board of Supervisors of Pennsbury Township held a regular meeting on Monday, July 19, 2004. Karen Wood, MaryAnna Ralph, Kathy Howley and David Patten were present and the minutes approved as submitted.

Carl Mehn from the County Emergency Services was present and gave an award to Reese Reynolds recognizing his completion of training and being appointed the Emergency Management Coordinator by the governor. Carl presented him with two plaques to recognize his training courses completed and a small gift. The Board thanked Mr. Reynolds for his dedicated service to the township.

Matt Houtman, township engineer, reported the following:

Knoll drainage project – storm sewer is done. Work is steady but slow. There will be some clean up because of the recent heavy rains. The job should be done in 2 weeks. Several residents were present and complained about the job. Matt will go out to check. He stated they should call his office if there are any complaints about the job. Chandler Ridge – run off problems continue to exist. This will be on the agenda for the next meeting; however,

MaryAnna will be on vacation and asked if this might be postponed until August 16th. Matt has to check with the Conservation District.

Courts at Longwood – landscaping continues to be done. Dave Patten asked Matt for figures to draft a maintenance bond.

Hillhurst - There is no homeowner's association formed yet. Dave and Matt will follow up with Jack Becker.

A municipal oversight agreement with Crosslands for their pumping station was signed by the Board. There has been no communication from Mr. Bravacos with regarding to the Kates Subdivision. Mr. Patten said he would follow up and report on when this subdivision will be resubmitted. Mr. Patten also stated that the lease agreement for the township apartment automatically renews for one year from August 15, 2004. Ms. Howley will let the tenants know. Ms. Howley also stated that Governor Rendell is reducing the number of state troopers and the graduating class has only 30 instead of the previous 100 cadets.

A bill list dated July 19, 2004 numbering 6435-6489 was submitted and approved by the Board. With no further business the meeting adjourned. At 8:10 p.m.
