SUPERVISORS' MINUTES AS OF THIS DATE

At the February 21, 2007, Pennsbury Township's Supervisors meeting, Mr. Fenton read into the record that his predecessors on the Board had been derelict in their duties by failing to follow an outlined schedule to issue reports on progress of the HC/MU/Act 527 up-date. Specifically, about three reports had never been issued.

Subsequently, it was established that scheduled issuance of these reports had been postponed by general agreement known to all involved parties. Therefore, the accusation that the supervisors were "derelict" was not correct.

At subsequent meetings, Mr. Fenton has refused to correct the record and acknowledge that no such "dereliction" had in fact occurred. This memo is being entered into the record by the undersigned because of concern that this "dereliction" could ultimately be cited in legal proceedings, to the embarrassment of the supervisors concerned, even though it is contrary to fact.

At the May 7th meeting, the undersigned has once again requested Mr. Fenton to withdraw his charge of dereliction, to correct the record. Since he has once again refused to do so, it is requested that this memorandum be included in the meeting minutes, so that in the future a citation will exist that no "dereliction" occurred.
