

PENNSBURY PLANNING COMMISSION MINUTES
JANUARY 12, 2021

The virtual Organization Meeting started at 5 p.m. Dennis Smith moved to offer the following slate for 2021 Officers: Dennis Smith, Chairman, Vice Chairperson Corinne Murphy and Jeff Streitel Secretary. Lynn Luft seconded the motion. There was no discussion and a vote was taken. All members were in favor and the motion passed.

Lynn Luft will continue as the Planning Commission's rep on the Historic Commission.
Judi Wilson – Pennsbury Township's rep on the Brandywine Battlefield Task Force.
Kennett Area Reg. Planning Commission rep position will remain vacant since there have been no scheduled meetings in the past year. When that commission resumes meeting, we can address who will attend. Dennis Smith moved to appoint these Township representatives to these commissions and Corinne Murphy seconded the motion. A vote was taken and all members were in favor. Motion carried.

Planning Commission meetings for 2021 will continue to be on the 4th Tuesday of the month at 5:30 p.m. Workshop dates are set at March 9, 2021 and October 13, 2021 at 5:30 p.m.

Ms. Howley will contact the Board of Supervisors to arrange a date for the 2021 Planning Seminar. It was agreed that the format of the meeting will change. Three topics, one being solar, will be offered for discussion. Members will send suggestions for two additional topics to Dennis Smith to be added to the agenda.

Dennis Smith announced there will be a virtual meeting on January 26th at 5:30 p.m. At that time there will be a review of the Adams reverse subdivision as well as a discussion on solar energy with Brandywine Conservancy consultant Kathleen McCaig. Mr. Houtman will have the Adam's review letter to members before Jan. 22nd. Dennis Smith also reminded members to send Mike Clements their additional thoughts on solar energy amendments as requested by him in his last email.
