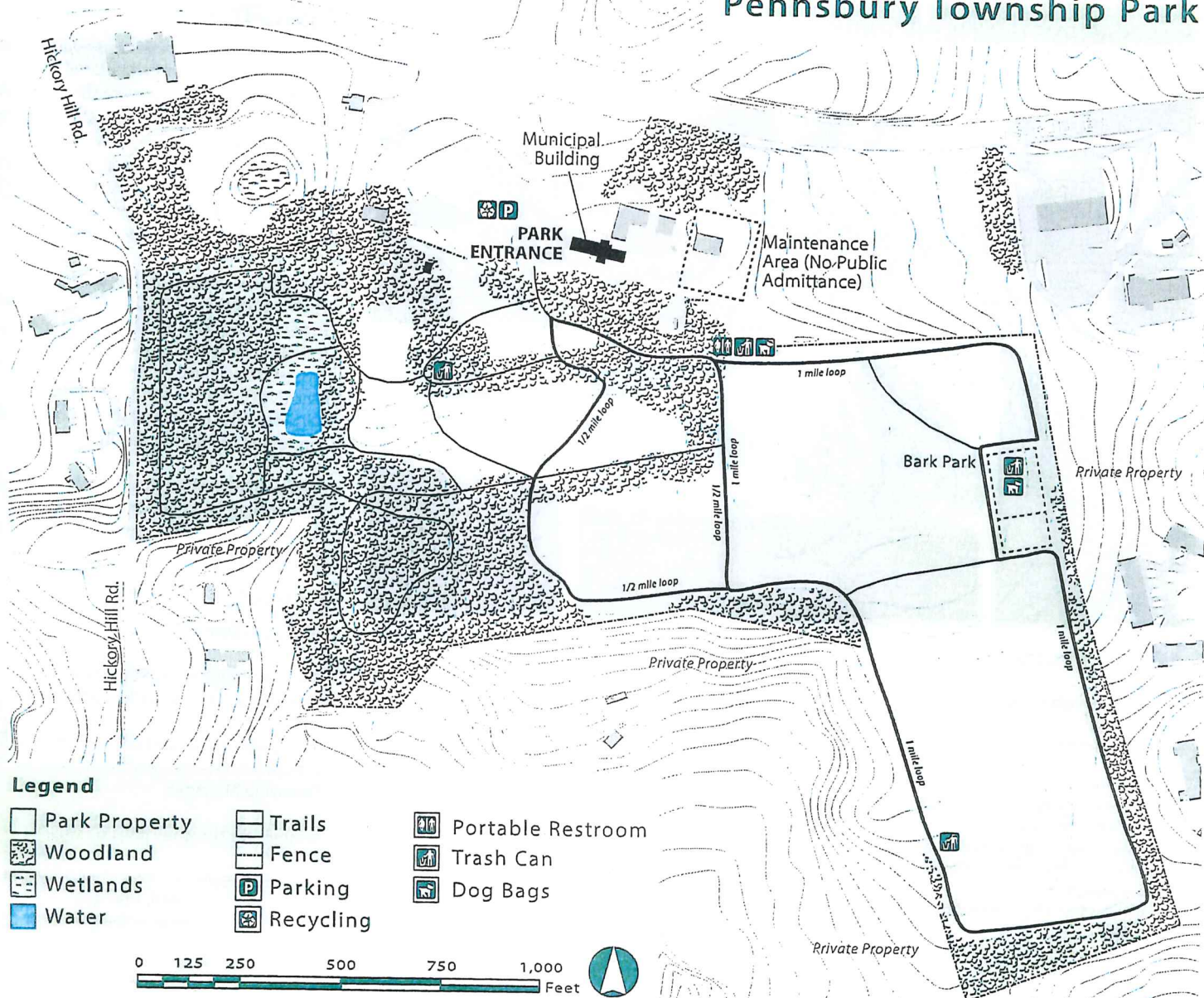


Pennsbury Township Park

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- Hunting
- Fishing
- Consuming alcoholic beverages
- Operating motor vehicles beyond parking areas
- Riding bikes in woods or wet areas
- Starting fires except in grills in picnic area
- Littering
- Swimming
- Ice skating
- Boating
- Climbing fences
- Cutting trees

HISTORY

Pennsbury Township Park was acquired in 1996 from the Layton Family Limited Partnership. Funds to acquire the park were provided by Chester County's Open Space Grant Program, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Keystone Grant Program, and Pennsbury Township. Before its purchase by the Township, the property was actively used for livestock and crop farming.

Planning for the use of the park is an ongoing process. The goal of the Board of Supervisors is to carefully plan for the recreation and open space needs of the Township residents, while remaining sensitive to the environment of the Park property. Environmental studies have been conducted to identify sensitive areas.
